Due to the delicate fibres, gentle brush strokes are recommended, letting the abrasiveness of the fibreglass do the hard work. It is recommended to wear protective gloves and face wear as debris from the fibreglass and material can irritate the skin if it comes into contact.

### How to control alter the length of the fibreglass bristles:

In order to extend the bristles of the fibreglass, simply turn the dial on the top of the pen clockwise or anticlockwise, depending on whether you want to retract or expose more of the bristles.

### Accessories:

Fibreglass be refilled, if the glass fibres become worn out or too short, they can be easily replaced with replacement glass fibre tips such as the fibreglass bristle.
